Dear Students,

Greetings. My heartfelt thank you for the support to all of you for supporting us in all our endeavors (Teaching learning/ continuous assessments) during this unprecedented global crisis because of Covid - 19. The MHRD, UGC and Uttar Pradesh State Government have issued guidelines to educational institutions. At this backdrop, the University did extensive deliberations and brainstorming exercises regarding conduct of End Term Examinations and promotions. Accordingly, keeping the best interest of the students in mind, Academic Council of Galgotias University has taken the following decisions regarding End Term Examinations and promotions whilst ensuring compliances, guidelines and norms of various regulatory bodies mentioned above. However, **“this is a special provision and applicable only this semester and shall not be treated as precedence in future.**

1. Detention:	No student will be detained due to shortage of attendance in this semester.*
2. Examination of Graduating Students:	2.1 End Term Examination (ETE) will be conducted only for Graduating students for Theory, Lab/Project / Capstone Project / Internship
	2.2 Passing Criteria for Graduating students – As per rules and regulations of GU, the minimum CGPA requirement is 5 for UG and 6 for PG which shall be as it is. While processing the results, minimum 40% marks overall is required with a minimum of 25% marks in ETE. End Term Examination will be conducted online having duration of 1.5 Hrs. Question paper shall have 60 questions carrying 30 marks.
3. Examination of Non-Graduating Students:	3.1 The results of all non-graduating students for theory courses will be processed based on their IA and scaling up MTE performance.
	3.2 The results of all non-graduating students for Lab/ Project / Capstone Project / Internship courses will be processed based on their continuous evaluation (IA) and Viva-Voce.
	3.3 All the grades below B shall be treated as Pass (P) Grade and shall be promoted to higher class.
	3.4 The online registration for next semester shall be open for only those students who have cleared their dues from 17 th June -2 nd July 2020. Classes to be commenced from July 6 th 2020 for 20-21 academic session .

<p>4. Project Evaluation of PG Students:</p>	<p>For Project Evaluation of Post Graduate students, publication of a Research Paper will be a prerequisite.</p>
<p>5. Examination of Detained/ Not Eligible students:</p>	<p>For Detained (Debarred) and Not Eligible students of graduating, non-graduating and students from previous batches (prior to 2019-20)/passed out batches, continuous performance during the summer term will be considered for calculating the grades. Four/Five internal Assessments (IA) and one MTE shall be conducted and the same will be taken in to account for computing the Grades.</p>
<p>6. Vacation Examination:</p>	<p>Vacation Examination shall be conducted only for graduating students. Since Intermediate students are all promoted on the basis of internal assessment only, so there shall not be vacation exams for this academic session. However, those who want to improve the Grades, can also apply for the papers along with graduating batch for which separate circular shall be taken up.</p>
<p>7. Back Paper Examination:</p>	<p>7.1 Graduating and Non-Graduating students can apply for both even and odd semester back paper examinations. **</p> <p>7.2 Back Paper examinations of Graduating, non-Graduating and students from previous batches (prior to 2019-20)/passed out batches will be conducted along with the End term Examinations of Graduating students. Back paper examination of all odd and even semester will be conducted online having duration of 1.5 Hrs. Question paper shall have 60 questions carrying 30 marks which will eventually be scaled up to 50 marks</p> <p>7.3 Schedule of back paper examination is as below :-</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Even Semester Back Paper: July 1 to July 15 2. Odd Semester Back Paper: July 16 to July 30 <p>7.4 Graduating and Non-Graduating students can apply for both even and odd semester back paper examinations.</p> <p>*It is expected that students shall complete term work.</p> <p>** University has given an opportunity to non-graduating student for Odd Semester backlog paper as a special case only for July 2020 cycle exam which cannot be taken as precedence in future.</p>
