Rule Booklet



Guidelines

- **Open to all engineering students pursuing undergraduate studies in BE/BTech across all branches.**
- **A team can comprise only members from the same college/institute.**
- **Number of participants allowed: 1 to 4 per team.**
- **No student can be a member of two teams.**
- **Any idea proposed beyond the domains and its respective subdomains of the contest will not be considered.**
- **The presentation needs to adhere to the format provided for the specific rounds.**
- **The projects which have already been submitted elsewhere will not be considered and can lead to disqualification.**
- **No hardware projects are allowed.**
- **Submissions will not be accepted after the respective deadlines.**
- **Any one of the subdomains from the above can be chosen by the teams.**
- **One team can choose only one subdomain.**



- **The registrations will be done on Dare2Compete .**
- **There is no registration fee.**
- **There are five domains for the hackathon along with respective subdomains.**

Hackathon Details:

Idea submission round

- **In this qualifying round, a team has to choose one subdomain and devise a solution related to any real world problem based on it.**
- **The last date for idea submission is April 01, 2022 (Friday) by midnight.**
- **Participating teams need to submit the idea as a presentation abiding by the format provided by us on D2C.**
- **The presentation should be converted into a PDF before submission. Any other file format will lead to disqualification.**
- **Name of the PDF file should be in the following format: 'TeamName_Leader'sName'**
- **The maximum number of slides in the presentation should be limited to 8. Failure to abide by this rule will result in marks deduction.**
- **Only the team leader has to make the submission.**
- **Each submission will be judged on the basis of the following parameters: novelty of the idea, technology used, architecture and clarity.**
- **Results for this round will be declared on April 04, 2022 (Monday) by evening. Only the selected teams will move to the next round of the hackathon.**



Qualifier Round

- **The second round of HackCoVIT2022 will begin on April 05, 2022 (Tuesday) at 11:00 AM sharp.**
- **The team will get 24 hours to work on the idea submitted in the first round and submit the project.**
 - **The submission link will be active for these 24 hours.**
- **The submission will close on April 06, 2022 (Wednesday) at 11:00 AM.**
- **Only the team leader has to make the submission.**
- **The team has to submit the following as the final submission:**
 - **An unlisted YouTube link of a video explaining the project along with a demo.**
 - **Link of the GitHub repository of the project.**
- **The 'README.md' file of the GitHub repository should explain the implementation of the project in detail in the following segments:**
 - **Introduction**
 - **Modules implemented and their explanation.**
 - **Screenshots of the project**
 - **Step by step installation guide: It should explain how one can run this application after cloning it from GitHub and also include all the libraries required.**
 - **YouTube video link**



- **All commits to the repository should be strictly made within the course of the hackathon (April 05, 2022 to April 06, 2022).**
- **Plagiarism will lead to disqualification.**
- **Selected teams will move to the final round on April 09, 2022 (Saturday). The list of these teams will be released on April 07, 2022 (Thursday) by afternoon.**

Final Round

- **In this round, the selected teams will give the final presentation along with a short demo of the project through video conferencing.**
- **It will be judged by a jury of eminent experts from various industries.**
- **More details regarding this round will be communicated with the qualified teams.**
- **Winners will be declared on the basis of their innovative idea, project execution and presentation skills.**
- **Final results will be declared tentatively on April 11, 2022 (Monday) by evening.**



Discord Server Guidelines:

The discord server is to be joined by every participant mandatorily as it will be the source of communication for the hackathon.

- **Link to join the discord server is available on the D2C platform.**
- **All team members have to join the server.**
- **Edit your nickname after joining the server.**
- **Every team leader's name should be in the following format:**
- **TeamName_Leader_YourName**
- **Every team member's name should be in the following format:**
- **TeamName_YourName**
- **Please refrain from spamming on the server as it is for communication purposes.**
- **There is a separate channel for queries on the server, use it for the discussions and questions.**
- **Do not contact the moderators of the server personally and discuss your queries on the specified channel only.**

**Note that the decision of the jury will be final and binding.
No argument or appeal will be entertained.**
