



Important Instructions to Students

1. CAT-I will be conducted offline at Galgotias University campus.
2. Students are advised to carry University Identity Card and Hall Ticket to the examination hall, failing which they will not be allowed for examination.
3. **Students should enter the examination hall before the commencement of the examination. Late comers may be allowed subject to a maximum by 15 minutes from the commencement of examination on exceptional grounds only.**
4. Students shall not be allowed to carry mobile phones, electronic gadgets (Other than the scientific calculator) or any other type of incriminating material in the examination Hall.
5. Students shall not be allowed to carry prohibited items such as books, written papers, or any other type of incriminating material in the examination hall for a closed book examination.
6. **Students are instructed to fill the OMR. Answer Scripts without filled OMR bubbles will be treated as null and void. Use blue/black pen only to fill the bubbles in the OMR Grid.**
7. Students are advised to read and follow instructions printed on the answer booklet and check the answer booklet for number of pages and for its condition before writing.
8. Exchange or borrowing of pen, pencil, eraser, scale, calculator, etc. during examination is prohibited. In emergent situations, these may be permitted through the invigilator only.
9. **No student is permitted to leave the examination hall till exam ends.**
10. Students must sit according to their seating plan.
11. No supplementary sheet will be provided. Rough work can be carried out on the right-hand side margin or at the end of the answer booklet.
12. Students are instructed to leave the left and right hand side margin (atleast 2 inches) of each page in the answer booklet.
13. Students are advised not to make any type of identification mark on the answer booklet as that would be considered as an act of use of unfair means.
